The petition has been filed against the refusal to approve the petitioner's appointment as Lecturer Social Studies in the College run by the fourth respondent/Management.

2. At the time of issuing notice of motion, vide order dated 04.01.2001, it was ordered that the petitioner's services would not be terminated till further orders. He continued in service and, as per learned counsel for the petitioner, has superannuated therefrom. He availed one year extension in service as well. Since the petitioner continued in service on the basis of an interim order granted by this Court and retired on attaining the age of superannuation, it goes without saying, he will be entitled to all benefits for the service rendered, in accordance with law.
