JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. On 14.02.2025, the following order was passed:

“Counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that husband of petitioner passed away on 09.05.2007 and he had retired on 30.04.2007. The petitioner was issued different cheques including cheque No. 107859 dated 27.09.2007 of Rs. 3,57,656/-. The said cheque was never deposited in bank by respondents.

Mr. Prince Singh, Advocate prays for a short accommodation to ascertain the factual position.

Adjourned to 17.03.2025.”

2. Mr. Prince Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and filed his power of attorney. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.



3. During the course of hearing, Mr. Prince Singh produced bank account statements of respondent-Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited (for short, ‘DHBVN’) as well as certificate dated 15.03.2025 of Central Bank of India, disclosing that aforesaid cheque was credited in the account of petitioner on 11.10.2007.
4. In the wake of certificate of Central Bank of India and bank account statements of petitioner as well as respondent, the present petition stands disposed of.
5. The petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application, if she finds that aforesaid amount credited in her account was received from a source other than respondent- DHBVN.
