1. Learned counsel representing the petitioners admits that, the First appeal under Section 96 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, against the impugned judgment passed by the trial Court is maintainable before the First Appellate Court. However, he submits that the trial Court has not framed the decree.
2. As per Order 41 Rule 1 of the Code of Civil Procedure,1908, the appeal can be filed before the First Appellate Court while annexing the copy of the judgment. The petitioner may also simultaneously apply for preparation of the decree to the trial Court.
3. With these observations, the revision petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appeal before the First Appellate Court.
