1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail, under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, in FIR No.0094, dated 10.10.2024, under Section 406, 420, 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Banur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 13.02.2025, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked her to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that a perusal of the FIR in question clearly reveals that it is on account of the marriage between the daughter of the petitioner and son of the complainant turning sour that exaggerated

allegations have been levelled for reasons but obvious. It has also been submitted that daughter of the petitioner, after her marriage with son of the complainant, had also obtained emergency protective order in USA, against the complainant in July 2024, after being threatened.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 13.02.2025, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for her custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 13.02.2025, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
