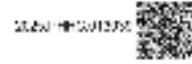

1. Present petition was filed in the year 1999 alleging that after the retirement, the pensionary benefits have not been released to the petitioner.
2. In the reply filed on behalf of the respondents, it was mentioned that there were disciplinary proceedings, which were initiated against the petitioner due to which, his leave encashment and gratuity was withheld by the respondents though, 100% provisional pension has been paid to him.
3. Learned counsel for the respondent-State on telephonic instructions from Ms. Sarita Dhingra, Superintendent Grade-I, O/o Chief Engineer Head Quarter, PWD (B&R), Patiala submits that during the pendency of the present petition, all the benefits accruing to the petitioner have already been released in favour of the petitioner.



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4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to rebut the said fact and submits that though, he is not in contact with the petitioner but in case, the benefits have already been released to the petitioner, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent-State in case any of the relief for which the petitioner was entitled for, is yet to be released to him by filing appropriate representation.

5. Ordered accordingly.

6. Civil miscellaneous application pending, if any, is also disposed of.
