1 The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been invoked seeking quashing of FIR No. 103, dated 06.07.2018, under Sections 384, 506 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 and Section 67 of Information Technology Act, 2000, registered at Police Station Division No.2, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 02.02.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. In pursuance of order dated 12.03.2024, report dated 08.04.2024 has been received from Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar wherein, it is observed that as time prescribed by this Court vide order dated 12.03.2024 has expired, as such, no statement of parties has been recorded qua compromise.

Accordingly, no report regarding compromise could be filed.



3. From perusal of afore-said report, it is evident that the parties could not appear before the Illaqa Magistrate within stipulated period as farmed by this Court vide order dated 12.03.2024. Moreover, today, the case has been called twice neither counsel for the petitioners nor counsel for respondent No.2 has put in appearance, which is sufficient for this Court to infer that parties are not interested in pursuing the present petition.

4. In view of above, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
