1. The instant petition has been filed for directing the respondents for counting the *Adhoc* service of the petitioner into regular service towards his service benefits for all intent and purposes and for granting all consequential benefits.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that, at this juncture, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.2-the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Group Centre, CRPF, Durgapur-14 (W.B.) is directed to look into the advance notice dated 05.11.2024 (Annexure P-6) and the grievance espoused by the petitioners therein and a speaking order is passed thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sudhir Nar, Sr. Panel Counsel, for the respondent-UOI, who is present through V.C., accepts notice on



behalf of the respondent-UOI and submits that he has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

5. Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and respondent No.2-the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Group Centre, CRPF, Durgapur-14 (W.B.), is directed to take note of the advance notice dated 05.11.2024 (Annexure P-6) sent by the petitioners and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law preferably within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
