This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of criminal complaint case No.9378 dated 05.09.2014 under Sections 138/142 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 (Annexure P-1) and notice of substance of accusation under Section 251 Cr.PC (Annexure P-4) along with all subsequent proceedings.
