NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.125 dated 20.12.2024, registered under Sections 498-A, 323, 506, 376(2)(n) IPC at Police Station City Dhuri, District Sangrur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 15.02.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigation Officer and has joined the investigation. However, Mediation remained unsettled.



3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Darshan Singh has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 15.02.2025 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C/482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
