1. This is a petition filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 776 dated 08.12.2023 under Sections 406,420 IPC and Sections 10, 24 of Immigration Act registered at Police Station Krishna Gate, Thanesar District Kurukshetra.
2. This Court, vide order dated 06.03.2024, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Arresting/Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 482(2) of the BNSS (erstwhile Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.)
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.03.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the



investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 06.03.2024 is **made absolute**. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
