1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.68 dated 14.06.2024 registered under Sections 498A and 406 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Women Police Station, Sector-17, Chandigarh.

2. Reply by way of an affidavit of Ms. Jaswinder Kaur, CPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Women & Child Support Unit, Sector-17, Chandigarh, on behalf of respondent No.1-State, has been filed in the Court which is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 24.02.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

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4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from IO Satish Kumar, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 24.02.2025 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
