Status report by way of affidavit of Lavdeep Singh Gill, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (HQ)-cum-Sub Division, Fazilka filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, is taken on record.

In the aforesaid status report in para No.5, it has been mentioned that both the petitioners are major. During the course of enquiry, statements of both the petitioner were got recorded. Copy of statements of the petitioners are annexed with the status report as Annexure R-1/T and Annexure R-2/T. Petitioner No.1 stated that earlier she was living with petitioner No.2 in live-in relationship and had filed the present petition but now she is living separately from petitioner No.1 with her own free will and she performed her marriage with one Sewa Singh son of Balveer Singh, resident of village Allupur, District Mansa and now she has no concern with petitioner No.2. Petitioner No.2 in his statement also reiterated that earlier

both were living in live-in relationship but now they are living separately with their own free will. Petitioner No.1 went back to her own village and her parents had performed her marriage and now she has no concern with petitioner No.2. Both the petitioners have stated that now they have no threat perception towards their life and liberty, so there was no need of any security to protect their life and liberty and as such, the present petition has become infructuous.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
