On 04.03.2025, the following order was passed:-

Contends, inter alia, that petitioner is ready to bear the costs of Rs.20,000/- on account of his inadvertent lapse for non-appearance on the relevant date before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Rohtak (for short 'JMIC').

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1/State; seeks time to have instructions and/or to file written response in the matter.

Notice to respondent No.2 in due course.

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In the meanwhile, petitioner shall join the proceedings before learned JMIC and on doing so, he shall be released on interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds subject to her satisfaction.

Costs be deposited with Punjab and Haryana High Court Employees Welfare Association, Account No.37167209613, IFSC: SBIN0050306, maintained with State Bank of India, Punjab & Haryana High Court Branch, Chandigarh.

Learned District and Sessions Judge, Rohtak, is requested to supply the complete details of complaints pending under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, as on 28.02.2025.

On 26.05.2025, the following order was passed:-

Contentends that in compliance of order dated 04.03.2025 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined proceedings before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Rohtak and was released on interim bail. Further contends that costs of Rs.20,000/- in terms of order dated 04.03.2025 has already been deposited.

Report of learned trial Court regarding complete details of complaints pending under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, as on 28.02.2025 has also been received.

On request of learned counsel for the petitioner, posted for 28.07.2025.

Fresh notice be also issued to respondent No.2 for the date fixed.

Till the next date of hearing, interim order to continue



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3. The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has complied with the aforementioned orders inasmuch as he has deposited a sum of Rs.20,000/- and has joined the proceedings before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Rohtak and has been granted the concession of interim bail.

4. In view of the aforementioned arguments raised, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Disposed of.

5. It is expected that the petitioner shall not absent himself from the Trial without a sufficient cause in future.
