At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer and has submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to the official respondents No.2 to 4 to decide the representation dated 20.01.2025 (Annexure P-2). He further submitted that the petitioner has submitted the aforesaid representation before respondent No.4 - the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh Police Headquarters raising his grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon.
