The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.96, dated 22.06.2024 under Sections 307,506,148,149 of IPC and under Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur (Annexure P-1).
