1. Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, seeking quashing of cross case i.e. DDR No. 10 dated 04.01.2018 (P-2), under Sections 325, 506, 201, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dehlon, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, in FIR No.0221 dated 28.12.2017, registered under Sections 324, 323, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Dehlon, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, on the basis of compromise. Further seeking quashing of order dated 20.02.2020 (P-4) and 22.11.2023 (P-3), whereby the petitioners have been declared as proclaimed persons.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there are total five accused in case FIR No.0221 dated 28.12.2017, registered under Sections 324, 323, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Dehlon, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana and proceedings qua three namely; Jorawar Singh, Kashmir Singh and Manvir Singh, have already been quashed on the basis of compromise, by this Court vide

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order dated 18.07.2023, passed in CRM-M-20642-2022. Counsel further submits that remaining two accused i.e present petitioners are residing in South Korea and Canada respectively, & were declared as proclaimed person vide orders dated 20.02.2020 (P-4) and 22.11.2023 (P-3). Counsel submits that present petition has been filed through special power of attorney only for quashing of the proceedings on the basis of compromise.

3. Neither the petition has been filed by the accused themselves, who were declared as proclaimed person; nor same can be considered as a competent one, being not duly embossed, counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file a fresh & competent petition with better particulars.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as sought and recorded hereabove.
