In the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for directions to the respondents to count the work-charge service rendered by the petitioner for the purpose of retiral benefits.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has placed reliance on the judgement of this Court in “Simarjit Singh vs. Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd. and Another” (CWP No.11081 of 2015, decided on 19.03.2019).

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner on the instructions from the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied if, at this stage, direction is given to respondent No.3 to decide his representation dated 19.06.2024 (Annexure P-13) in a time bound manner. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 does not have any objection if the representation dated 19.06.2024 (Annexure P-13) is decided by respondent No.3.

In view of the statement given by the counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice (Annexure P-13) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
