1. The petitioners are seeking the concession of anticipatory bail, under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, in FIR No.272, dated 19.12.2024, under Sections 331(6), 115(2), 324(4), 191(3), 190 of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 17.02.2025, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioners and asked them to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners, *inter alia*, contends that although false and fabricated allegations have been levelled against the petitioners, however, even otherwise they have been attributed only simple injuries in the occurrence in question. It has been further submitted that the petitioners had been granted concession of interim bail by the learned trial Court, however, due to some misunderstanding they could not join investigation. He further submits that the petitioners would join the investigation.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of order dated 17.02.2025, the petitioners have joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioners having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioners are not required for further investigation much less for their custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 17.02.2025, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
