1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking reimbursement of medical expenses incurred by him on the treatment of his wife.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner concedes that first bill of Rs.4,30,520.94/- has already been cleared, however, respondent has not cleared second bill of Rs.2,96,000/-.
