1. Compliance report by way of an affidavit of Sh. Uma Shankar Gupta, Director, Department of Rural Development and Panchayats, Punjab on behalf of respondent No.2 has been filed in Court, the same is taken on record.
2. Learned State counsel on instructions submits that arrears of salary for seven months along and GPF shall be paid to the petitioner within 07 days from today and the case of petitioner with respect to family pension shall be approved and arrears thereof along with monthly pension shall be released within four weeks thereafter.
3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondent(s), learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
4. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
5. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
