JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners through the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of order dated 28.2.2020 whereby the petitioners were terminated from services.

2. This Court while issuing notice of motion on 27.3.2000 stayed the operation of the impugned order. The order dated 27.3.2000 reads as:-

“Notice of motion for 10.8.2000.

*In the meanwhile, termination of the services of the
petitioners shall remain stayed.”*

3. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad-idem* that on account of aforesaid interim order, the petitioners continued to work and few of them either have retired or passed away.
4. It needs to be mentioned here that the instant petition was filed by 19 persons.
5. Considering the fact that the petitioners are working since 2000 and few of them have either retired or passed away, I find it appropriate to make absolute aforesaid interim order.
6. Disposed of accordingly.
7. Pending misc. application, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
