JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of order dated 13.01.2003 whereby respondents No.4 to 20 were promoted as Leading Fireman. They are further seeking direction to respondents to consider them for the post of Leading Fireman.

2. Learned State counsel submits that respondents No.4 to 20 were promoted prior to petitioners because they complied with stipulated criteria. There was no discrimination and promotion was made as per Rules. The petitioners have already retired.

3. In the backdrop, this Court does not find it appropriate to interfere with impugned order. Accordingly, the instant petition is hereby ***dismissed.***

4. The petitioners are at liberty to move an appropriate application within three months from today, if cause survives.
5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
