1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobedience of order dated 23.11.2023 passed by this court in CWP-26293-2023.
2. There is nothing on record to show that the petitioner himself had complied with the part of the order of the Writ Court which was required to be complied with by him. Neither any application filed by the petitioner was annexed with the writ petition nor has any such application been attached with the contempt petition, as such.
3. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any further. Hence the same is dismissed.
4. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unaddressed, he will be at liberty to avail any other remedy, but in accordance with law.
