ANIL KSHETARPAL, J(Oral)

1. The defendant assails the correctness of First Appellate Court's order remitting the matter back to the trial Court for fresh decision after allowing application for permission to lead additional evidence.

2. During the pendency of the case, the trial Court has already recorded the additional evidence and the case is now coming up for final arguments on 28.03.2025.

3. The order passed by Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Barnala, on 19.03.2025, reads as under:-

"The learned counsel for the plaintiff has tendered some documents into evidence and also closed the adducing additional evidence, vide separate statement. Now to come up on 28.03.2025 for arguments."

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid development, it would not be appropriate for this Court to interfere at this stage.

5. With these observations, the appeal is disposed of without commenting upon the merits of the case.

6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
