Petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, herein is, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of impugned order dated 28.11.2024 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.1 whereby well-reasoned order dated 10.02.2020 (Annexure P-5), order dated 13.12.2019 (Annexure P-4) and order dated 01.11.2019 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Assistant Collector 1st Grade has been wrongly set aside.

1.1 A further prayer has been made to stay the operation and implementation of the impugned order dated 28.11.2024 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.1.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the documents attached along with the applications are not correctly translated and certain

more facts are required to be pleaded, so he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to file a fresh one with better particulars.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
