1. For the reasons stated in the application, delay of 133 days in filing the review application is condoned.

2. CM stands allowed.

Review application

3. The petitioner prays for review of the order dated 22.08.2024 wherein his writ petition was dismissed. SLP (Civil) No.30250 of 2024 filed against the judgment of the High Court has been dismissed on 20.12.2024, with the following order:-

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“No case for interference is made out in exercise of our jurisdiction under Article 136 of the Constitution of India. The Special Leave Petition is accordingly dismissed.

Pending applicaiton(s), if any, stand disposed of.”

4. Heard learned senior counsel representing the review applicant. He submits that Regulation 27 of the University Employees Leave Regulations is not workable because 75% of the total strength of the Teachers of the Department is not present and working at a particular point of time.

5. Regulation 27 is categoric. The petitioner’s request for paid study leave was declined by the Department on the basis of Regulation 27(4). There is no challenge either in the writ petition or in the review application to the validity of the aforesaid Regulation. Hence, it is for the University to examine its workability.

6. Consequently, no ground to review the order dated 22.08.2024 is made out.

7. Dismissed.

8. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
