JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. As common issues are involved in the captioned petitions, with the consent of both sides, the same are hereby disposed of by this common order. For the sake of brevity and convenience, facts are borrowed from **CWP-17388-2002**.

2. The petitioners are claiming that respondents No.4 to 13 have been sent for intermediate school course even though they are not confirmed Head Constables and this is in clear violation of Rule 13.9 of Punjab Police Rules, 1934 (for short 'PPR').

3. As per reply, respondents No.4 to 13 are female officers.

They have been rightly sent against seats earmarked for lady officers.

4. The matter relates to selection of Head Constables for intermediate school course. With the efflux of time, claim of petitioners has become insignificant.

5. ***Dismissed*** with liberty to the petitioners to move an appropriate application within three months from today, if cause survives.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
