SANJAY VASHISTH. J.(Oral)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR (Annexure P-2 and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Counsel for the petitioner informs this Court that there are total 06 accused in this case and 04 of them have filed the instant petition. He submits that being it a partial compromise, the same is not maintainable in view of the observations made by the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in **Rakesh Das v. State of Haryana and another** [CRM-M-48043-2023 (O&M)] (Decided on : **12.11.2024**) : **Law Finder Doc Id # 2663704**.
3. Faced with the situation, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file a fresh and comprehensive one, by impleading all the necessary parties including all the accused/victims.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty sought and recorded hereinabove.
