1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that it is a case where the petitioner has challenged the action of the State, vide which he has sought a direction to be issued to respondent No.1 to renew his arms license. He further submitted that in fact before filing the present petition, the license of the petitioner was cancelled, which was not in his knowledge and the aforesaid cancellation order has been attached along with the status report filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 as Annexure R1/T dated 22.02.2024. He further submitted that now as the petitioner has become aware of the aforesaid order, he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition in order to enable the petitioner to challenge the same in accordance with law before the appropriate authority/appellate authority. He also submitted that the petitioner will file an



appeal as early as possible along with an application for condonation of delay and the concerned authorities may be directed to consider the aforesaid application for condonation of delay sympathetically and in accordance with law.

2. On the other hand, Ms. Neha Sonawane, DAG, Punjab submitted that since the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition in order to avail appropriate remedy available to him in accordance with law, she has no objection with regard to the same.

3. After hearing the learned counsels for the parties, the aforesaid request made by the learned counsel for the petitioner is accepted. The petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file an appeal or avail any other remedy in accordance with law. In case an application for condonation of delay is filed by the petitioner before the appropriate authority/appellate authority, then the same shall also be considered in accordance with law and preferably in a sympathetic manner.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
