The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short – BNSS) in FIR No.06 dated 20.01.2025, under Sections 110, 115(2), 126(2), 351(2), 191(3), 190 of BNS Act registered at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 20.02.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
