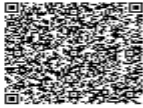

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS for issuance of directions to the official respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.2 dated 06.01.2025, under Section 64 of BNS, registered at Police Station Bahawala, District Fazilka.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an accused in FIR No.2 dated 06.01.2025 and he is seeking fair investigation. She submitted that a representation was filed vide Annexure P-4 to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka but no action has been taken by the police.
3. At this stage, learned State counsel has submitted on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh that in the present FIR the petitioner has already been arrested and the investigation is going on. He submitted that so far as the representation (Annexure P-4) is concerned, the same has already been considered and nothing was found in the allegations made in



the aforesaid representation.

4. In view of the above, nothing would survive in the present petition because the matter is still at the investigation stage and the representation which was filed by the petitioner vide Annexure P-4 has already been considered by the police and consigned to record, as per learned State counsel.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
