1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.3 and 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, endangered at the hands of private respondents No.5 and 6 and to decide the representations moved by the petitioner.
2. Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ellenabad, District Sirsa on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 in the Court today, which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions. As per the reply, a civil litigation is pending between the parties, pertaining to their plot before the Civil Court, and that the petitioner is habitual of filing complaints.
3. No ground is made out to issue directions, as prayed for.
4. Accordingly, the instant petition stands dismissed.
