The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.1 to 6 restraining them from conducting/initiating any fresh inquiry in case bearing FIR No.80 dated 16.06.2024 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 341/506/186 of IPC registered at Police station Baghapurana, District Moga.

The learned State counsel has filed status report dated 20.03.2025 by way of affidavit of Sh. Dalbir Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Baghapurana, District Moga, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 & 6-State in the Court today in compliance of order dated 19.02.2025 passed by this Court and the same is taken on record.

The learned State counsel refers to the affidavit and submits that during the investigation, it has been found that respondent No.7 is an NRI and he is mostly residing abroad. The petitioner and respondent No.7 are neighbours and they are loggerheads due to the dispute of street/passage and in

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order to put pressure on respondent No.7-Jagtar Singh, the FIR (*supra*) was registered by the petitioner. Further, during investigation, the veracity of the allegations made by the petitioner are found to be false and the Investigating Officer has recommended the cancellation of the FIR (*supra*) on 01.02.2025 and the report is likely to be submitted before the jurisdictional Court after the approval of the senior officers.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to invoke alternative appropriate remedy on the same cause of action in accordance with law for redressal of grievances raised in the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
