The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case DDR No.20, dated 14.04.2024, under Sections 324,323,506,148,149 of IPC (new Sections 118(1), 115(1), 351(2), 191(3), 190 of B.N.S, Police Station Sadar Faridkot, (Annexure P-1), later on added offence under Section 326 of IPC (118 of B.N.S) vide rapat No.11, dated 30.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) in case FIR No.46, dated 14.04.2024, under Sections 341,323,427,506,148,149 of IPC, Police Station Sadar Faridkot (Annexure P-3).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 21.02.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 21.02.2025, passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioners shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
