1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 B.N.S.S for quashing of the impugned order dated 05.09.2024, Annexure P-4, passed by JMIC, Ambala, whereby the bail of the petitioners have been cancelled due to their non appearance and non-bailable warrant of arrest has been issued in FIR No. 67 dated 06.09.2023 under Section 406/498-A/506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Women, Ambala.

2. Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, HQS, Ambala, District Ambala, on behalf of respondent/State filed in Court is taken on record, copy of which has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

3. Perusal of the paragraph No.14 of the reply shows that petitioner have been granted bail by the trial Court, the same is reproduced as follows:

“14. That in compliance of the order dated 21.02.2025, passed by this Hon'ble Court, on dated 17.03.2025 both the accused-petitioners appeared before the Ld. Trial Court and moved an application for grant of bail and after hearing arguments from both the sides at length, granted bail to both the accused-petitioners.”



4. In view of the above, since the petitioners have joined the proceedings and have been granted the concession of the bail, no further orders are required to be passed at this stage.

5. The present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand(s) disposed of.
