By way of present petition filed under Section 482 BNSS, 2023, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

29	18.01.2025	13(A) of the Gambling Act and 318(4) of BNS.	Old Industrial District Panipat

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 02.04.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. During the course of hearing on 02.04.2025, following order had been passed: -

“ 2. *Heard.*

3. After considering the submissions, it is not disputed that the persons indulged in gambling at the spot were apprehended by the police party. The petitioner is claimed to be named in the alleged disclosure statement made by the



co-accused namely Vijay @ Rinku dated 18.01.2025 (Annexure R-3), whereby it is clarified that he had named one Deepak but now he has named the petitioner. No specific overt act is attributed to the petitioner.

4 . Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (BNSS).

5. Adjourned to 30.04.2025.

6. Investigating Officer (concerned) to remain present in Court along with relevant records on the date fixed.”

4. Learned State counsel on instructions received from ASI Joginder informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 02.04.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 02.04.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.



- 6. The petition stands allowed.
- 7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
