1. This order will dispose of the above mentioned both the petitions as the similar question of law and facts are involved therein.

2. The present petitions have been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ of certiorari, for quashing the orders dated 15.10.1997 and 19.12.1997 passed by the Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar vide which the approval of the petitioner as lecturer in Computer Science has been refused with further prayer to allow the revised pay scale of Rs.8000-13500 to the petitioner w.e.f. 01.01.1996.

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19.10.2022, therefore, on 05.03.2024, notice was ordered to be issued to the petitioner which was received back with the report "not residing at given address". Thereafter, on 08.04.2024, notice was ordered to be issued to Mr. Dinesh Kumar Jangra, Advocate, counsel for the petitioner.

4. As per office report, Mr. Dinesh Kumar Jangra, Advocate, counsel for the petitioner has been informed through e-mail. However, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, even today also. It appears that the petitioner is not interested to pursue the present petitions.

5. In this view of the matter, the instant petitions are dismissed for non-prosecution.
