The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to call the status report from respondents No.2 to 4 concerning to the complaint dated 12.12.2024 (Annexure P-5).

In compliance of order dated 24.03.2025 passed by this Court, affidavit of Sh. Sandeep Kumar Malik, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Hoshiarpur has been filed in the Court today on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5-State which is taken on record.

The learned State counsel, at the very outset, refers to the said affidavit and submits that the grievance raised by the petitioner in the present petition has been substantially redressed and the FIR No.67 dated 12.05.2025 under Sections 329(4)/324(3)/61(2) of BNS has been registered at Police Station Mahilpur, Hoshiarpur and thereafter, a DDR No.21 was recorded on 14.05.2025 and offence under Section 305 of BNS has been added.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition as the same has become infructuous.
