By way of present petition filed under Section 482 BNSS,  
2023, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as  
under: -

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance  
to the order dated 11.03.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. During the course of hearing on 11.03.2025, following order  
had been passed: -



*“ Status report dated 10.03.2025 in the form of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, H.Q. Rewari, District Rewari, has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.*

*2. Heard.*

*3. Admittedly, the co-accused Sharukh alias Sarup and Mustafa alias Billu alias Sem were sent for trial in the present FIR and they have since been acquitted vide order dated 04.12.2023 (Annexure P-3). It is also not disputed that the recovery had already been effected from those accused.*

*4. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been nominated on the basis of co-accused Sharukh alias Sarup, who has already been acquitted in the main case.*

*5. Be it the case, without commenting on the merits, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.*

*6. List on 02.04.2025.*

*7. Investigating Officer of the case to remain present in Court along with record on that date.”*

4. Learned State counsel on instructions received from ASI Vijender Singh informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.



5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 11.03.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 11.03.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.

7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
