By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR as under:

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
205	31.12.2024	115 (2), 118 (1), 333, 191 (3), 190, 126 (2), 3 (5) of BNS and 109 of BNS added later on.	Sadar Patiala, Patiala.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 06.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 06.05.2025.

3. Learned State counsel intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

4. During the course of hearing on 06.05.2025, following order was passed:



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“ Heard.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner could not join the investigation in terms of the order dated 07.04.2025 on account of miscommunication and undertakes that the petitioner will join the investigation for which some time is requested.

3. In the interest of justice, the petitioner is again directed to join the investigation within seven days from today in compliance to the order dated 07.04.2025 and in that event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023.

4. Investigating Officer of the case to remain present along with record on the next date of hearing.

5. Adjourned to 22.05.2025.”

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 06.05.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 06.05.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.



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7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
