1. Petitioner – Balwinder Singh @ Sunny has filed the instant quashing petition based on the compromise through his Power of Attorney (POA), Kuldeep Singh @ Kuldip Singh. Besides, respondent No.2 – Balvir Chand, is the father of the complainant – Vijay Kumar.

Thus, both sides, in fact, have no concern with the impugned FIR, which is sought to be quashed on the basis of compromise.

2. This petition, being not maintainable, is hereby **dismissed**.

However, it will be open for the concerned parties (accused and the complainant/victim) to file a competent petition, in accordance with law.
