This writ petition was filed assailing the action of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathana in reducing the duty hours of the petitioner from 18 hours to 10 hours a day.

No interim orders were granted in the writ petition.

When the matter was taken for hearing on 29.11.2019, Mr. Govind Rana, learned counsel, appeared for Mr. Harkesh Manuja, learned counsel for the petitioner, and sought time to enable him to ascertain as to whether the cause of action in this case still survives. The case was accordingly posted on 4.12.2019.

Today, Mr. Govind Rana, learned counsel, would again request for a further adjournment. The record does not reflect in clear terms as to whether the petitioner would still be in service as on date. Unless it is established that the cause in this writ petition still survives, the

question of adjudicating it on merits does not arise. Neither Mr. Govind Rana, learned counsel representing Mr. Harkesh Manuja, learned counsel for the petitioner, nor Mr. Shrenik Jain, learned counsel for the respondents, are in a position to assist this Court in this regard.

The writ petition is accordingly dismissed for non-prosecution.
