1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 483 of BNSS for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 0016 dated 10.02.2024 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana (Rural),.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that from a perusal of the FIR, it is apparent that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and has been falsely involved without any incriminating evidence against him. He further contends that even at the time of alleged offence, the petitioner was confined in jail in case FIR No. 14 of 2023 and certain documents were forged and fabricated to get him released from jail. He further contends that the petitioner was arrested

in the present case on 29.05.2024 and challan has already been presented against him. Learned counsel has placed reliance on the orders (Annexures P-1 to P-5) passed by this Court, whereby, co-accused, namely, Mandeep Singh @ Manga, Pawan Kumar @ Tony, Vijay Kumar @ Lucky, Dharminder Kumar and Manjit Singh have been granted the concession of bail.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that the petitioner is a habitual offender and two more cases have ordered to be registered against him.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

5. In the present case, the petitioner is stated to be in custody for the last about 09 months and after completion of investigation, challan has been presented against him. Even, other similarly placed co-accused, namely, Mandeep Singh @ Manga, Pawan Kumar @ Tony, Vijay Kumar @ Lucky, Dharminder Kumar and Manjit Singh have been admitted to bail by this Court vide annexures P-1 to P-5.

6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail

bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty
Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.
