1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 14.08.2004 whereby Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran (SSP) ordered to deduct 40% from his carry home salary in order to recover Rs.6,34,398/- which was paid to him as back wages.
2. The petition was admitted on 20.02.2007 and operation of the impugned order was stayed vide order dated 03.09.2004.
3. Learned State counsel submits that petitioner passed away on 17.03.2008 and nothing has been recovered from the deceased.
4. In the wake of aforestated factual position, interim order dated 03.09.2004 is hereby made absolute.
