RUPINDERJIT CHAHAL, J. (ORAL)

1. Through the instant petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (For short "BNSS"), the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.257 dated 24.10.2024 under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, Police District Commissionerate, District Jalandhar.

2. On 20.02.2025, following order had been passed: -

“ Petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.257 dated 24.10.2024 under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, Police District Commissionerate, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that essentially it is an inter se dispute between close family relatives as the petitioner is none other than the maternal uncle of the complainant. Learned counsel asserts that it is on account of some civil dispute pertaining to a property, which is in the possession of the complainant that false and exaggerated allegations have been made in the FIR in question with respect to the fabrication of a



forged declaration of statement and some business agreement.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. H.S. Deol, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

At this stage, Mr. Kartik Patial, Advocate, has entered appearance on behalf of the complainant and filed his power of attorney, which is taken on record.

Adjourned to 22.05.2025.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and appear before the investigating agency as and when called upon to do CRM-M-10007-2025 -2- so. In the event of his arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS/438(2) Cr.P.C.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated On 20.02.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

4. Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Inspector Ravinder Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated On 20.02.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
