1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 07.02.2023 whereby he was ordered to be compulsorily retired on attaining the age of 55 years.

2. Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana, at the outset, submits that petitioner has already been convicted by Trial Court, thus, petitioner cannot be retained in Service.

3. Mr. Samrat Malik, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has preferred appeal against judgment of conviction and matter is pending before this Court. He has also filed an application seeking stay of judgment of conviction.
