JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of order dated 20.05.2003 whereby petitioners were subjected to B-1 Test for promotion to the post of Head Constable (HC).

2. The petitioners were recruited as Constable in Telecommunication Wing of Punjab Police. They passed Operator Grade Third Course. The respondent asked them to pass B-1 Test as per Punjab Police Rules.

3. Learned State counsel submits that petitioners were promoted as HC in 2006 and further promoted as Assistant Sub Inspector (ASI) in 2021, thus, the prayer sought has rendered infructuous.

4. In the wake of statement of learned state counsel, the petition is ***disposed of*** as having been rendered infructuous.

5. The petitioners are at liberty to move an appropriate

application within three months from today, if cause survives.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
