1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to her in case FIR No.29, dated 24.01.2025, under Sections 406,420 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala (Annexure P-1).
