KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a *mandamus* upon the respondents to de-freeze the bank account of the present petitioner.

2. On the last date of hearing, i.e. 12.05.2025, it was informed to this Court that the account of the present petitioner has already been de-frozen, and is now operative since 27.03.2024, however, a lien has been marked on an amount of Rs.5,350/-, only, that too, on the directions of the Cyber Crime Cell.

3. On last date, since no one had caused appearance on behalf

of the present petitioner, the matter was adjourned for today, with a direction to be listed in the urgent list, and further observation was made that no request of adjournment shall be entertained on behalf of either of the parties.

4. Today, the case was called twice, however, no one has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

5. It seems that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant matter, as her most of the grievance seems to have been redressed.

6. **Dismissed** for want of prosecution.
