N. S. SHEKHAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.0163, dated 26.06.2024, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of IPC, 1860 read with Section 24 Immigration Act, 1924, registered at Police Station Mataur, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as counsel for the victims/complainants submit that the matter has been amicably



resolved between the parties and the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation may not be required.

3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 24.02.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
